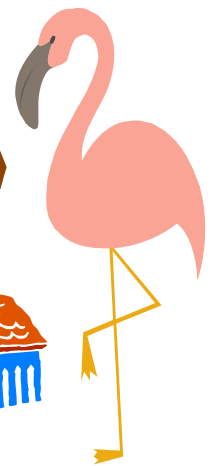
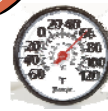

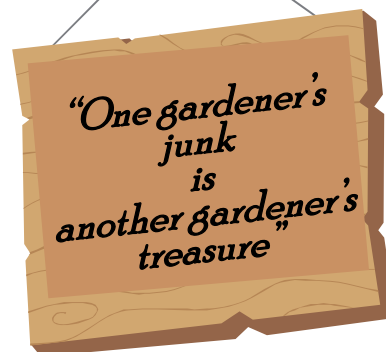

RULES

2nd Annual Garden Art Swap 2010

“One man’s junk is another man’s treasure”

We gardeners have all purchased or been given gifts for our gardens that we have tired of or which no longer fit our garden theme. If you are downsizing or simply want to “re-gift” that “pink flamingo” you received, now’s your chance!

This is how it works:

- Participants arrive with their junk (we mean garden art)
- They cue up and wait for an “Appraiser” (that’s us - Staff)
- They pay their \$3.00
(to support Horticultural Education Programs just like this one)
- Their stuff is “appraised” based on original value, rarity and condition
- They are given a chit which they use like money to buy other Garden Art
- Our Super Duper Volunteers place the Garden Art out for Traders to view

A chit is given for each item that meets the standards of the staff. You can combine chits to trade or can get “chit change” if your trade was of lesser value than your trade “appraisal”. You may have chits leftover but no monies will be refunded, nor will any items be returned.

Here’s our Chit Chart

item worth up to \$5	½ point
item worth from \$5 - \$9.99	1 point
item worth from \$10 - \$19.99	2 points
item worth from \$20.00 - \$34.99	3 points
item worth from \$35 - \$49.99	4 points
item worth from \$50 - \$74.99	5 points
item worth from \$75 - \$149.99	6 points
item worth from \$150.00 and up	7 points
