

"BRANCHING OUT!"

"Branching Out!" is an exciting and educational gardening program for young people between the ages of 5 and 13. The program offers a unique opportunity for young people to gain hands-on experience in gardening under the guidance of an outstanding staff from the Horticultural and Natural Resources Education Division of the Morris County Park Commission.

Beginning in April, gardeners meet weekly on Saturdays to prepare the soil and plant their gardens. The program requires regular attendance and commitment on the children's part as they plant, maintain and harvest vegetables, herbs and flowers from their plots. The summer session also offers many imaginative garden related activities such as lessons on trees, insects and plants. Gardeners participate in a variety of projects utilizing plants they have grown themselves including cooking, drying herbs and flower arranging.

Gardeners may register for the Full Season program (Spring & Summer) or for only the Spring or only the Summer Session. The fee includes use of the garden plot, all the needed tools, seeds, transplants, craft supplies, and instruction for the various projects. Financial assistance based on family need is available. The Morris County Park Commission invites everyone to participate in its programs. For further information, or if your child has special needs, call 973.631.5004.

"Branching Out!" is administered by The Friends of The Frelinghuysen Arboretum with assistance from garden clubs and individuals in cooperation with the Morris County Park Commission. Gardeners meet in the Haggerty Education Center at The Frelinghuysen Arboretum, 53 East Hanover Avenue, Morris Township (across from the County Library).
