Mid Atlantic (MABS) Spring Festival - April 25-27, 2014

Please plan on attending this year's Mid Atlantic Bonsai Societies (MABS) Spring Festival, held this year at the **Ramada Inn** on **Route 10 West** in **East Hanover, NJ**. It's only minutes from our usual meeting place in Morristown, an easy drive from all major highways.

The fun starts Friday afternoon with three concurrent **hands-on workshops** (check for availability), with guest artists **Suthin Sukosolvisit, Corin Tomlinson,** or **Takashi lura**. The vendor area opens between 4-6 pm, offering pots, tools, wire, soil, trees, accent plants, DVDs, and you name it. At 8:00 pm there will be a lecture/demo by **Suthin**. Saturday starts with the vendor area opening at 8:00 am and more lecture/demos by all three guests throughout the day. Professional **critiques** of the trees on display will be held at 5:30 and 6:45 pm. The **club members' exhibit** will be open all day as well. A **banquet and auction** starts at 8:00 pm.

Fees apply to all workshops, lecture/demos, and critiques, and availability is limited. Go to http://midatlanticbonsai.freeservers.com/fescurr.htm for details.

The vendor and display areas open again at 8:00 am Sunday, with final lecture/demos by all three artists going till noon, at which time everybody packs up and heads for home.

General admission to the bonsai display and vendor areas is \$20.00 and well worth it. For all other activities you may register in person or online (I suggest online, and ASAP). Please register as a member of the GSBS – our club receives a portion of the cash surplus in proportion to our participation in the workshops and lectures.

April Meeting: Tuesday, April 29th

Please note that this month's meeting takes place on the LAST Tuesday of the month, and features **guest artist Suthin Sukosolvisit**, fresh from his appearance at this year's **MABS Spring Festival**. GSBS will host a **paid workshop** (see notice on next page) to be held at our usual meeting room at the Frelinghuysen Arboretum – *sign up now if you wish to participate, space is limited!* Following a break for dinner, Suthin will join us for our **regular meeting at 7:00 pm** to discuss the art of bonsai using **your trees** for reference/demo material, in addition to trees that have been worked on at the afternoon workshop. Attendance at the 7 pm meeting is free to the public, as usual.


Workshop Featuring Mr. Suthin Sukosolvisit

Stoughton, Massachusetts. Suthin has extensive experience with tropical bonsai, but also with Japanese maple, Juniper, Azalea and Black pine, among many other species.

Plant Care Tips for April

Ready, set, GO! April is still a decent month for root-pruning, and for digging trees from yard or field. As the weather finally settles into "normal" springtime mode—that is to say, temperatures climb into the 50s and 60s, and stay there—begin your feeding, pinching, watering, and pruning schedules in earnest. Of course, be mindful of potential cold snaps, and be ready to protect vulnerable plants. The very hard winter we have just experienced lingers on, in the form of late bud-break, so watch your trees for signs of genuine activity before throwing on the fertilizer.
