This month we have <u>TWO</u> meetings! April 14th, Repotting Workshop/Demo with trees you bring; April 21st, Guest Artist Budi Sulistyo, fresh from MABS.

April 14th, bring your tools, pots, and a tree or two, or three, for a full-on **repotting workshop** (club soil, wire, and plastic bonsai pots provided for newbies), where you can get a real workout with the guidance and assistance of our more experienced club members. This is the right time of year for repotting, and several newer members have expressed interest in having a helping hand to get them through the process. We encourage our more experienced members to bring a tree to demonstrate with as well. **Don't forget your mixing tubs to help control the overflow!**

April 21st, bring a tree or two to a **lecture/demo with guest** artist Budi Sulistyo, visiting the United States from his native Indonesia for this year's MABS Spring Festival. His most recent book, "Tropical Bonsai Gallery," was published in 2008. He continues to write for local and international magazines, and he has taught Bonsai on National Television in Indonesia since 1985. Numerous countries have invited him to give demonstrations and workshops and to judge Bonsai. He is renowned for his work with tropical bonsai, but please bring along any tree that you'd like advice, insights, or hands-on help with.

We will also, on the same day, host an **afternoon workshop with Budi** (bring your own trees), from noon to 4:00, for \$50.00 per participant. Contact Fred to sign up.

Plant Care Tips for April

Ready, set, GO! April is still a decent month for potting, repotting, and root-pruning, and for digging trees from yard or field. Begin your feeding, pinching, watering, and pruning schedules in earnest. Of course, be mindful of potential cold snaps, and be ready to protect vulnerable plants. Heaven knows, after this crazy winter, this is the time we've all been waiting for! [JM]

We Still Have Bags of Akadama and pumice for sale!

Fred still has Akadama soil, in two granule sizes—2.5 mm (small grade) and 5.0 mm (medium grade). Bags are 18 liters, about 22 lbs. Cost per bag is \$40.00, which is a good price. Fred also has **pumice** at \$3/lb.
