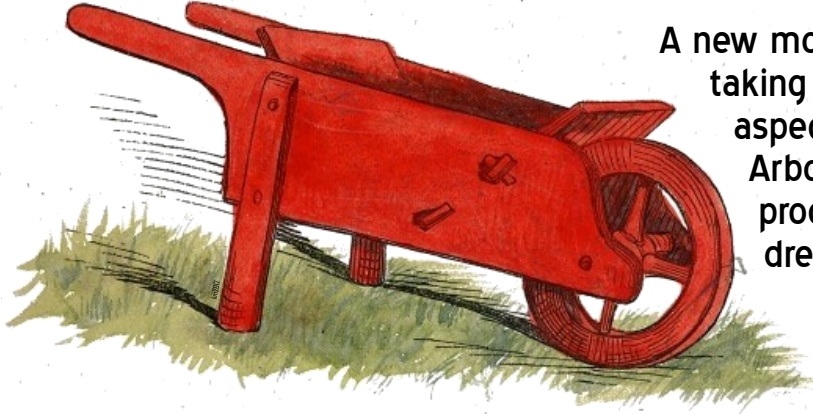


What's So Great About...

Shade Gardens
